Sensor.Community is a contributor driven global sensor network that creates Open Environmental Data.

Our Objectives (not definitive – and a start not an end)

- Raise awareness of Air Quality issues in the community
- Target private individuals (esp. parents), schools & local authorities
- Encourage community management of Air Quality issues
- Build credibility for sensor.community solutions
- Credible community led AQ data collection beyond legal norms.

How Sensor.Community in Calne?

'Calne Our Place'

a town-focussed improvement group In around 2017 luftdaten.info



became known through a Town Twinning with **Eningen** near Stuttgart. Despite the A4 running through the centre of Calne - insufficient interest at the time led to no action.





How Sensor.Community in Calne?

In early 2019

luftdaten.info appeared again at a 'Calne Our Place' meeting.



Could have been nearly a case of insufficient interest leading to no action, again! But...





How Sensor.Community in Calne?

So we embarked on the Calne Air Quality project with luftdaten.info



Got off to a quick start with help from a **Town Twinning** friend from **Eningen** who was already involved.





Why Sensor.Community in Calne? Air Quality was and is an issue in Calne We are on the A4 with ½ a bypass!

Initial aims:

- Build 2 or 3 test units to gain experience & confidence
- Get 'Calne Our Place' to fund individual units to start us off, along with one or two individual members.





Why Sensor.Community in Calne?

Follow on aims:

- Got the Town Council involved (success)
- Try to get a calibration arrangement with Wiltshire Council (no success to date)

Covid-19 hasn't helped!






Why Sensor.Community in Calne?

Covid-19 was on its way:

- Got three private units installed before first Covid-19 lockdown.
- Town Council invested in 10 kits,
 7 allocated for Schools







Why Sensor.Community in Calne?

Currently:

Starting to build a schools
 programme linked into upper
 Keystage 2 (ICT) curriculum, to
 build and deploy AQM devices.

Success for Sensor.Community in Calne?

- Heightened pupil & parent awareness of AQ through schools engagement
- Greater community AQ awareness, through ubiquitous access to graphical data



...Transforming local authority action to improve AQ

 Ongoing deployment of wider AQ monitoring devices covering other pollutants.

The Sensor Device


- USB 5vDC powered
- Local Wifi Streaming
- Working on a Solar version with battery backup
- Innovative use of drain pipe!







The Sensor Active Components









- ESP8266 V3 Microprocessor/WiFi
- SDS011 PM Laser Sensor
- BMP280 Sensor (Temp/Humid/Air pressure)
- 5vDC USB Plug-top Power supply
- and two drainpipe elbows!
